Welcome to the Ceredigion update...

SUSTAINABLE SOCIAL SERVICES THIRD SECTOR GRANT 2016 – 19.

The purpose of the new grant is to support Welsh Ministers' priorities of a new and equal relationship between people and practitioners; early intervention and prevention; transforming the way people's needs for care and support are met. The All Wales Forum is delighted to announce that they have been successful in their grant application which not only allows the AWF to continue with their current work but to look at the new, much needed, 'All Together Now' project. A partnership with the Alzheimer's Society, Cartrefi Cymru and Cardiff and Vale parents federation. There are four strands to this project:

Family Foundations - work with younger families **Building strong communities** - working age families **Ageing well** - older families

Communicating well together - a national communications project.

The project will look at things like respite, moving into community living, social enterprises, dementia care, etc. through joint working with Carers and the organisations across Wales.

The success of the grant application is a huge achievement for those involved in its submission. I also see it as a clear expression of support for the core aim of the AWF 'To bring a national voice and recognition to parents and carers of children and adults living with LD in Wales', by the WG. I believe this grant reaffirms that the WG acknowledges the positive role the AWF has played and will continue to play as the national body for family carers.

Turning Point has launched a new health toolkit, written and developed by a dedicated team of nurses aiming to improve the health and wellbeing of people with learning disabilities. This is a very good reference document of just over 100 pages, meant to be used as and when required. It will be of benefit to both carers and professional's.

Carers Allowance – your questions answered

CONTACT a FAMILY have produced a new podcast mini-series to help answer some of your <u>frequently asked</u> <u>questions about Carers Allowance</u>. If you ever wondered who qualifies for <u>Carers Allowance</u>, if you'd be better off financially by claiming it or how your earnings or savings will affect your claim then this podcast is for you.

Family Information Service Ceredigion. When was the last time you had a look at the FIS website? Plenty of information and a 'What's On' section. You can also submit an event or news article for their FIS bulletins. Just get the information to them at fis@ceredigion.gov.uk by midday on a Monday and they will ensure the information is included in their next bulletin. When looking I noted that the Family Centres at Borth, Penparcau and Lampeter all cater for children with additional needs, this does include children with LD, (I've asked). Also out of term time they cater for children up to the age of 12. Social Services and Well-being (Wales) Act 2014.
